Group Classes Which one should you attend?

<u> Piano Classes:</u>

Homeschool Piano: Group Class for Students who Homeschool. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs. This semester we will be focusing on Rhythm and playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Tuesday at 2:00 pm</u>. Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.

Beginning Piano Book 1: Group Class for Students who have not completed Book One of our piano course. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs found in Book One. This semester we will be focusing on Penta scales, key recognition, and reading rhythms. Later in the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>**Tuesday at 4:00 pm.</u>** Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.</u>

Older Elementary Book 2: Group Class for Students who have completed Book One of our piano course. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs found in Book Two. This semester we will be focusing on one-octave scales, chords, and reading the musical staff. During the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of

practice. This hour-long class will be held each **<u>Tuesday at 5:00 pm</u>**. Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.

Tween & Teen Book 2 & 3: Group Class for Students Grades 6th - 12th who have completed Book One of our piano course. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs found in Books Two & Three. This semester we will be focusing on one and two-octave scales, Major and Minor chords, and reading the musical staff and Lead Sheets. During the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Tuesday at 6:00 pm and Saturday at 12:30 pm.</u> Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.

Elementary Reading: Group Class for Students K-5th who have started learning to read music or struggle with reading notes fast. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs as we learn the concept of Sight Reading. This semester we will be focusing on Treble Clef, Bass Clef, and reading the grand staff. During the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Wednesday at 4:00 pm</u>. Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.

Tween & Teen Book 3 & 4: Group Class for Students Grades 6th - 12th who have completed Book 2 of our piano course. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs found in Books Two & Three. This semester we will be focusing on two-octave scales, Major and Minor seven chords, and advanced reading of the musical staff and Lead Sheets. During the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Wednesday at 5:00 pm</u>. Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.

Elementary Piano (1yr of exp): Group Class for Students who have taken a year of lessons and have completed Book One of our piano course or guitar students who have switched to piano. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs found in Book Two. This semester we will be focusing on one-octave scales, chords, and reading the musical staff. During the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Saturday at 10:30 pm</u> Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.

Elementary Piano Book 1 & 2: Group Class for students K-5th who have not completed Book Two. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through

real-life playing examples and songs found in Books One & Two. This semester we will be focusing on primer fundamentals as well as one-octave scales, and reading the musical staff. During the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Eight Handed Piano pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Sunday at 2:00 pm</u> Students will be granted access to other piano classes throughout the week as well as all five Study Hall Classes.

Guitar Classes:

Beginning Guitar Book 1: Group Class for Students who have not completed Book One of our guitar course. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs found in Book One. This semester we will be focusing on Penta scales, Fretboard recognition, and reading rhythms. Later in the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Guitar Ensemble pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Monday and Thursday at 4:00 pm.</u> Students will be granted access to all five Study Hall Classes.

Advanced Guitar: Group Class for Students 6th- 12th grade who have completed Book One of our guitar course or have special permission from the instructor. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs This semester we will be focusing on Penta, Blues & Major Scales, Fretboard recognition, and reading rhythms. Later in the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and Guitar Ensemble pieces. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Monday and Thursday at 6:00 pm.</u> Students will be granted access to all five Study Hall Classes.

<u>Ukulele Class</u>: Group Class for students K-5th who have not completed Book Two. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life playing examples and songs found in Books One & Two. This semester we will be focusing on primer fundamentals as well as advanced chords, and reading the musical staff and tablature. During the semester, we will be playing with other students in traditional duets and our Ukulele Choir. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be held each <u>Saturday at 9:30 am</u> and <u>Sunday at 1:00 pm</u> Students will be granted access to all five Study Hall Classes.

Voice Class: Group Class for our voice students. Students will learn a practical theory lesson each week which will be applied through real-life singing examples. This semester we will be focusing on primer breathing fundamentals as well as learning to create harmonies and reading the musical staff. During the semester, we will be singing with other students in traditional duets and our Musical Theater ensemble. Students will also be given individual assignments to do at home as we learn the discipline of practice. This hour-long class will be

held each <u>Saturday at 11:30 am</u> and <u>Sunday at 3:00 pm</u> Students will be granted access to all five Study Hall Classes.

Study Hall: Five 1 hour classes throughout the week where you can sign up on our website to attend in person or virtual (3rd grade & Up). Study Hall is for students who are enrolled in our group classes. Our Faculty will help facilitate your child's practice while teaching the student the discipline of practice.
